



## MetLife SpotLite on Oral Health<sup>SM</sup>

### *Preventive care is key to good oral health and improved health outcomes.*

All MetLife participating dentists have undergone a rigorous credentialing and selection process to join our network.<sup>1</sup>

MetLife's SpotLite on Oral Health<sup>SM</sup> is a special recognition awarded to dentists annually who have shown a focus on improved health outcomes.

#### **Q. What is the MetLife SpotLite on Oral Health<sup>SM</sup> program?**

**A.** The MetLife SpotLite on Oral Health is a program designed to recognize general and pediatric participating network dentists who have shown a focus on improved oral health outcomes.

#### **Q. Who is eligible for SpotLite designation?<sup>2</sup>**

**A.** General and pediatric participating network dentists, who see a minimum of 10 MetLife covered patients from the previous 12 months and meet health risk improvement criteria.

#### **Q. How do I know if my dentist is a SpotLite dentist? Or how do I find a SpotLite dentist?**

**A.** Dentists awarded SpotLite status are recognized on the MetLife "Find a Provider" page

#### **Q. How frequently can dentists earn SpotLite status?**

**A.** SpotLite status is awarded on performance from the previous 12 months. Dentists can opt-out of the program but cannot ask for inclusion or engage in any arrangement (financial or otherwise) to obtain SpotLite status.

#### **Q. Why would a dentist want to achieve SpotLite status?**

**A.** SpotLite status is a way to highlight their focus on improving health across their population, just like other awards it is a point of pride. In future years dentists who repeatedly achieve the SpotLite designation will be eligible for a rewards program for things like priority service, discounts on products and faster claims payments.
